Job Overview	To deliver afterschool care supervision to pupils ages 4–11 years old. To deliver a variety of age-appropriate activities and create a warm, safe environment at the end of the normal school day.			
Duties and Responsibilities:	<ul> <li>To be responsible for the setup of after school care in school, including a range of activities for all pupils;</li> <li>To deliver and set up a snack/light picnic style meal for all pupils and cater for their individual needs (including dietary requirements);</li> <li>To create and manage a caring, supportive, purposeful and stimulating environment;</li> <li>To engage all pupils during their time in after school club;</li> <li>To supervise children as they do homework;</li> <li>To promote high standards of behaviour and discipline;</li> <li>To promote actively strong and positive relationships with parentsand carers, communicating with them at the end of the session;</li> </ul>
